2023 DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

Case #2023-009BR

Respondent: Dominion Security Group LLC

Date: August 15, 2024

Disposition: Respondent violated Ala. Code 1975 § 34-27C-12(b)(1) (Prohibited activities) – “It is unlawful for a contract security company to fail to comply with or violate this chapter and the published rules of the board.” Respondent provided security services in Alabama without first obtaining a license as a contract security company and employed unlicensed security guards. Respondent entered into a consent agreement with the Board regarding the alleged violations. Pursuant to the consent agreement, Respondent was assessed a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and placed on probation for one (1) year. The probation period is August 15, 2024 through August 15, 2025.

Case #2023-010BR

Respondent: Arena Security and Protection Services LLC

Date: August 15, 2024

Disposition: Respondent violated Ala. Code 1975 § 34-27C-12(b)(1) (Prohibited activities) – “It is unlawful for a contract security company to fail to comply with or violate this chapter and the published rules of the board.” Respondent provided security services in Alabama after its Alabama Security Company license expired, Qualifying Agent license expired, and employed unlicensed security guards. Respondent entered into a consent agreement with the Board regarding the alleged violations. Pursuant to the consent agreement, Respondent was assessed a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and placed on probation for one (1) year. The probation period is August 15, 2024 through August 15, 2025.

Case #2023-015BR

Respondent: Nolan Security

Date: August 15, 2024

Disposition: Respondent violated Ala. Code 1975 § 34-27C-12(b)(1) (Prohibited activities) – “It is unlawful for a contract security company to fail to comply with or violate this chapter and the published rules of the board.” Respondent provided security services in Alabama without first obtaining a license as a contract security company and employed unlicensed security guards. Respondent entered into a consent agreement with the Board regarding the alleged violations.

Pursuant to the consent agreement, Respondent was assessed a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and placed on probation for one (1) year. The probation period is August 15, 2024 through August 15, 2025.
